Scholarship Guidelines

North Clackamas Education Foundation (NCEF) provides scholarships to graduating high school seniors to continue their education at a regional college or accredited trade school of their choosing. We believe that continuing education for our students represents the future of our community and of our country. NCEF hopes to encourage qualified students who may not receive other financial aid to continue their education by helping with their tuition needs.

NCEF will accept scholarship applications from graduating seniors who meet the following guidelines:

- ❖ Grade point average 2.5 or higher
- ❖ Attending an accredited regional college or trade school
- ❖ Scholarship will be used within one year of graduating
- ❖ Have a valid Social Security number

Scholarships will be presented at high school honors assemblies for seniors.

Unused funds, if any, shall be returned to NCEF. Payment of scholarship funds will go directly to the educational institution in which the student has enrolled. Applications for scholarships will be received and approved by the NCEF Scholarship Committee and be approved by the NCEF Board of Directors. No scholarships will be awarded to family members of the NCEF Board.

Scholarship recipients will notify the Foundation if they change schools.
