Please submit the following as four separate documents;

1. NCEF Bridges to Success Scholarship Application located at nc-foundation.org/applications – all scholarship applicants must submit this application, all applicants will be entered into the opportunity to receive a Bridges to Success Scholarship, if applicants are applying for more than one scholarship, they need only submit this application once.
2. A Counselor Recommendation Form located at nc-foundation.org/applications– all scholarship applicants must submit this form, only one form needed per applicant if submitting multiple scholarship applications, **applications will not be considered without this form.**
3. A document answering the following questions;
 - a. Essay: Describe your plans for the future. (About 500 words)
 - b. Choose two of the following topics (500 word minimum):
 - i. Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?
 - ii. Write about a time when you offered support to someone who needed it.
 - iii. How has Coach Aum impacted you? Whether this is personally or through his legacy.
4. Letter of recommendation from a current or former coach, teacher or mentor.
